Brother Douglas was born in Richmond, Virginia and spent his boyhood in that city. He moved to New York City and was employed in the clothing and tailoring business there for several years.

He came to Grand Rapids in eighteen hundred ninety-one as a cutter for Houseman and Jones Clothing Company and made this city his home. He was a well known tailor here for more than forty years, conducting a tailor shop on Monroe Avenue until he retired, two years prior to his death.

Brother Berry was a forty-four year life member of Grand Rapids Lodge No. 48, B. P. O. Elks when he passed away in Butterworth Hospital. He was survived by his widow and one sister.
